Chestnut Court

Chestnut Court is based in Stanwell, close to Junction 13 of the M25. It is around 2 miles from the shopping areas in Staines-upon-Thames and Ashford.

Purpose built in 2012, this extra care housing scheme is registered with the Associated Retirement Community Operators (ARCO).

With the support of staff and shared on-site facilities, living at Chestnut Court makes it easier for you to live independently.

There are 44 self-contained 1 and 2 bedroom apartments, each with a wet room and kitchen with a built-in oven and hob, Extra care is a real alternative to residential care if you are frail or vulnerable.

At Chestnut Court you will be spoilt for choice on places to relax, with a restaurant, communal lounge and patio area.

There is a hair salon on site with a therapy room for treatments like chiropody. There's also a computer suite and you can even have friends and family to stay in our guest room.

We run a range of social events and activities at Chestnut Court, including:

- Coffee mornings
- Music nights
- Singing groups
- Entertainment evenings
- Bingo
- Group outings and Activities centre every Thursday



To give you greater peace of mind there are a number of security measures in place too, including:

- Fob-access door security
- An emergency call system in each apartment

Trained care and support staff are available 24 hours a day to help you. Care is provided by A2Dominion. Who will tailor your care based on your individual needs assessment.

Our extra care support could include:

- Help washing, dressing and using the toilet
- Help with medication
- Help preparing meals
- General cleaning and laundry
- Shopping, collecting your pension and helping you with your finances
- Pressure care, catheter and colostomy care

You will have a dedicated Scheme Support Officer to coordinate your care. They will be on hand during the day to answer any questions you have.

Beechwood Court is located close to Junction 1 M3 Sunbury, close to shops and local amenities and transport links.

Beechwood Court is a high quality housing scheme for older persons, which provides care and support tailored to meet individual's needs. Residents can enjoy their social pursuits in a safe and secure environment, giving peace of mind to themselves and their families.

- Enhanced sheltered housing
- 40 flats. Built in 2006. Sizes 1 bedroom, 2 bedroom. Includes wheelchair standard properties.
- Extra Care scheme with on-site care staff, Visiting management staff (9am - 2pm Monday to Friday), Non-resident management staff (part time) and Careline alarm service
- Lift, Lounge, Dining room, Restaurant open to the public, Laundry, Guest facilities, Garden,



Hairdressing salon, Assisted bathing facility

- Whole site accessible by wheelchair. Access to site fairly easy. Distances: bus stop 10 yards; shop 30 yards; post office 1 mile(s); town centre 1 mile(s); GP 1 mile(s); social centre 10 yards.
- Regular Social Activities include: bingo, coffee mornings, quiz afternoons, singing afternoons, seasonal events, and gardening, organised by tenants. New residents accepted from 55 years of age.
